



2017 Thesis prize Société de Biologie

In 2017, a thesis prize of 1500 euros will be awarded by the Société de Biologie.

The prize is intended to reward a particularly remarkable PhD work in the field of « Genome modifications and control of gene expression », carried out partly or entirely in a French research laboratory.

The aim of the prize is to acknowledge a fundamental advance or a methodological development capable of breaking a technological lock.

The laureate will present his/her work in the course of the « Claude Bernard symposium » organized by the Société de Biologie on November 22, 2017, on the topic of « CRISPR: from a procaryote immune system to a technological revolution » at the Academy of Medicine in Paris. During the meeting, the thesis prize will be officially awarded to the laureate.

Transportation and local expenses of the laureate will be covered by the Société de Biologie.

The laureate will have to write a paper in French which will be published in « Biologie Aujourd'hui », the journal of the Société de Biologie.

The candidates should have defended their theses in 2016 and should send two pdf files with :

- The thesis text including a summary in French and in English
- A CV, a covering letter and a recommendation letter from her/his thesis director.
